AMENDMENT OF GENERAL NOTICE No. 572 OF 2014, POLICY DIRECTION WITH RESPECT TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF KARUMA, ISIMBA AND AYAGO HYDROPOWER PLANTS

(Under section 17 of the Electricity Act, 1999, Cap. 145)

This Policy Direction is given to the Electricity Regulatory Authority under section 17 of the Electricity Act, 1999, Cap. 145, this 29th day of July, 2020.

PREAMBLE

- WHEREAS**, the Government of Uganda prioritised the development of the 600MW Karuma Hydro Power Plant, the 183MW Isimba Hydro Power Plant and the 600MW Ayago Hydro Power Plant as Government public funded projects to keep tariffs at affordable levels,

the Government has developed Isimba 183MW Hydro Power Plant and is in the final stages of developing Karuma 600MW Hydro Power Plant utilising resources allocated under the Energy Fund, funding from the China Exim Bank and other development partners;

- WHEREAS**, the Government appointed Uganda Electricity Generation Company Limited (UEGCL) as its representative in overseeing the construction works and later as owner of the Hydro Power Plants developed by Government and further appointed Uganda Electricity Transmission Company Limited (UETCL) to oversee the construction of the power evacuation lines and related substations and later as owner of the related power evacuation infrastructure;
- WHEREAS**, the pre-feasibility studies for the 600MW Ayago Hydro Power Plant are complete and the feasibility study is at an advanced stage, and the Government had initially opted to utilise the Chinese contractors “China Ghezouba Group Company Limited (CGGC)” for the development of the then 600MW and now 840MW proposed Ayago Hydro Power Plant and its evacuation line with funding from the China Exim Bank, and this did not materialise;
- AND WHEREAS**, the Minister of Energy and Mineral Development issued to the Electricity Regulatory Authority a “Policy Directive with respect to the development of Karuma, Isimba and Ayago Hydro Power Plants” on 5th September, 2014 under General Notice No. 572 of 2014;
- NOTING THAT** as a result of the Government projections, the Ayago Hydro Power Plant is required in the generation mix in the medium to long term future energy needs of the Country;

POLICY DIRECTION

- NOW THEREFORE**, the following Policy Direction amending General Notice No. 572 of 2014 is given to the Electricity Regulatory Authority (the Authority) to observe and implement—

- The Policy Directive issued to the Authority with respect to the development of Karuma, Isimba and Ayago Hydro Power Plants issued on 5th September 2014 vide General Notice No. 572 of 2014 is hereby amended to allow Ayago Hydro Power Plant and its associated evacuation transmission infrastructure works to be implemented as a Build, Own, Operate and Transfer (BOOT) project.



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- (2) The Authority shall consider an application for a permit for feasibility studies and subsequently an application for a licence, taking into consideration the Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of Uganda and Power China International Group Ltd. dated 19th November, 2019 for the Build, Own, Operate and Transfer (BOOT) of the 840MW Ayago Hydro Power Project and its associated transmission line works in accordance with the Electricity Act, 1999, Cap. 145.
- (3) The Policy Direction issued under General Notice No. 572 of 2014 with respect to the 600MW Karuma and the 183MW Isimba Hydro Power Projects remains unchanged.
