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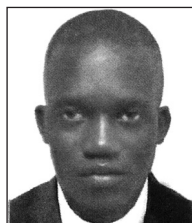

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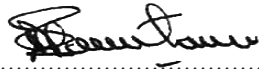

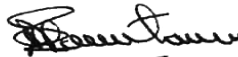

CORRIGENDUM

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC that this Corrigendum is issued to correct errors in the Revised Edition of the Principal Laws of Uganda, 2023 as follows—

1. THE ANTI-TERRORISM ACT, CAP. 120

a) Section 7 of the Anti-Terrorism Act is corrected to read as follows—

“7. Aiding and abetting terrorism, etc.

Any person who aids, abets, finances, harbours or renders support to a person, knowing or having reason to believe that the support will be applied or used for or in connection with the preparation or commission or instigation of acts of terrorism, commits an offence and is liable, on conviction, to suffer death.”

b) Section 8(1) and (2) of the Anti-Terrorism Act are corrected to read as follows—

“8. Establishment of terrorist institutions

(1) Any person who establishes, runs or supports any institution for—

- (a) promoting terrorism;
- (b) publishing and disseminating news or materials that promote terrorism; or
- (c) training or mobilising any group of persons or recruiting persons for carrying out terrorism or mobilising funds for the purpose of terrorism,

commits an offence and is liable, on conviction, to suffer death.

(2) Any person who, without establishing or running an institution for the purpose, trains any person for carrying out terrorism, publishes or disseminates materials that promote terrorism, commits an offence and is liable, on conviction, to suffer death.”

2. THE PENAL CODE ACT, CAP. 128

a) Section 23(4) of the Penal Code Act is corrected to read as follows—

“(4) Any person who advisedly attempts to seduce any person serving in the armed forces or any member of the police force or prison services or any other security service, by whatever name called, from his or her duty and allegiance to the Constitution commits an offence and is liable, on conviction, to suffer death.”

b) Section 116(3) of the Penal Code Act is corrected to read as follows—

“(3) Any person who performs a sexual act with another person who is below the age of eighteen years in any of the circumstances specified in subsection (4) commits a felony called aggravated defilement and is liable, on conviction by the High Court, to suffer death.”

c) Section 226(1) of the Penal Code Act is corrected to read as follows—

“(1) Any person who by force or fraud kidnaps, abducts, takes away or detains any person against his or her will—

- (a) with intent that that person may be murdered or may be so disposed of as to be put in danger of being murdered;
- (b) with knowledge that that person will probably be murdered; or
- (c) with intent to procure a ransom or benefit for the liberation of that person from the danger of being murdered,

commits an offence and is liable, on conviction, to suffer death.”

3. THE PREVENTION OF TRAFFICKING IN PERSONS ACT, CAP. 131

a) Section 2(2) of the Prevention of Trafficking in Persons Act is corrected to read as follows—

“(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), where the person convicted of the offence of trafficking in person exploited the victim of the offence by carrying out human sacrifice, the convicted person shall, instead of the punishment prescribed in subsection (1), be liable to—

- (a) suffer death, if—
 - (i) the convicted person is a parent, guardian or person having authority or control over the victim of the offence; or
 - (ii) the offence of trafficking in persons results in the death of the victim;
- (b) imprisonment for life, where the offence results in grievous bodily harm to the victim; or
- (c) imprisonment for ten years, where the offence results in injury to the victim of the offence.”

b) Section 23 of the Prevention of Trafficking in Persons Act, is corrected by deleting section 23- Power to amend Schedule.



4. THE PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS ACT, CAP. 177

Section 6(1) of the Parliamentary Elections Act is corrected to read as follows-

“(1) Whenever it is considered necessary and, in any case, immediately after the date of an election is appointed, the Commission shall transmit to every returning officer—

- (a) sufficient copies of this Act, and such instructions prepared by the Commission, as are required for the proper conduct of an election by the returning officer and to enable the returning officer to supply to each election officer a copy of those instructions as each election officer may require;
- (b) copies of the voters roll for each polling station within the electoral district;
- (c) sufficient blank report books and other election materials; and
- (d) sufficient funds to cover all the expenses to be incurred by the returning officer in carrying out the electoral process.”

6. THE NATIONAL SOCIAL SECURITY FUND ACT, CAP. 230

- a) Section 19(4) of the National Social Security Fund Act, is corrected by replacing the cross reference to section 22(2) with 23(2); and
- b) Section 24(2) of the National Social Security Fund Act, is corrected by replacing the cross reference to section 44(3) with 45(3).

7. THE INCOME TAX ACT, CAP. 338

- a) Section 40 (5) of the Income Tax Act is corrected by changing the cross reference from “subsection 3” to “subsection (4)”;
- b) Section 96 of the Income Tax Act is corrected by deleting “subsection (7)”;
- c) Section 152(1) and (2) of the Income Tax Act is corrected to read as follows-

Section 152- Power to amend monetary amount and Schedules

“The Minister may, by statutory instrument, with approval of Parliament, amend any monetary amount set out in this Act and the Schedules to this Act”.

- d) **Schedule 7** to the Income Tax Act is corrected by changing the cross reference from “section 29(1)” to “section 28(1)”.

8. THE TAX PROCEDURES CODE ACT, CAP. 343

Section 49(8) of the Tax Procedures Code Act is corrected by changing the cross reference from “subsection (5)” to “subsection (7)”.

9. THE VALUE ADDED TAX, CAP. 344

- a) Section 7(4)- is corrected by changing the cross reference from “subsection (1) or (5)” to “subsection (1) or (6)”;
- b) Section 21(4)- is corrected by changing the cross reference from “section 14(2)(a)” to “section 14”;
- c) Schedule 3-paragraph 1(aw) is corrected by changing the cross reference from “subparagraph (af)” to “subparagraph (ae)”.
