POLICY DIRECTION WITH RESPECT TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE 20MW SOLAR PV POWER PLANT BY PHOTON POWER UGANDA LIMITED IN SOROTI DISTRICT

(Under section 17 of the Electricity Act, cap. 145)

This Policy Direction is given to the Electricity Regulatory Authority under section 17 of the Electricity Act, Cap 145, this 17th December, 2024

PREAMBLE

1. WHEREAS the government of Uganda (the "Government") in the National Energy Policy published in 2023 set out the policy aspirations to meet the energy needs of Uganda's population for social and economic development in an environmentally sustainable manner
2. WHEREAS in achieving the fore mentioned objective, the government has deployed the strategy of disseminating renewable energy technologies to increase their positive impact on Uganda's energy balance and environmental stewardship;
3. WHEREAS the National Energy Policy 2023 aims to achieve an electricity generation capacity of 52,481 MW by 2024;
4. WHEREAS the Renewable Energy Policy 2007 for Uganda set out the Government's policy objective to make modern renewable energy a substantial part of the national energy consumption and to increase the use of modern renewable energy;
5. WHEREAS Government has undertaken to pursue the principal policy objective of improving power connectivity as provided for in the National Development Plan III and the National Resistance Movement manifesto 2021- 2026;
6. NOTING THAT Emerging Power Uganda is wholly owned by Tryba Energy
7. NOTING THAT Emerging Power Uganda Limited is the developer and owner of the 10MW Bufubuli Solar PV power plant in Mayuge District operating under License Number ERA/LIC/GEN/016/141
8. NOTING THAT Tryba Energy has registered Photon Power Uganda Limited as an SPV to develop the 20MW project in Ongongo Village, Acaboi Parish, Aukot Subcounty in Soroti District
9. NOTING THAT Photon Power Uganda Limited has completed the required preliminary prefeasibility studies in relation to the establishment of a 20MWAC ground-mount solar PV power plant in Ongongo Village, Acaboi Parish, Aukot Subcounty, Soroti District and plans to expand to 100MW in a phased-manner;

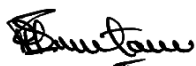

POLICY DIRECTION

7. NOW THEREFORE, the following Policy Direction is given to the Electricity Regulatory Authority to observe and implement;
- Photon Power Uganda Limited shall finance, construct, operate and maintain a 20MWAC ground-mount solar PV power plant in Ongongo Village, Acaboi Parish, Aukot Subcounty in Soroti District at a tariff to be determined by Electricity Regulatory Authority upon submission of a justifiable full feasibility study to be conducted by Photon Power Uganda Limited
 - The Power Purchase Agreement conditions shall be negotiated between Photon Power Uganda Limited and Uganda Electricity Transmission Company Limited.

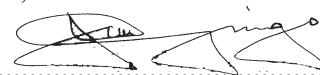
