APPLICABILITY OF PREVIOUS REFIT FRAMEWORK TO PRE-REVISION SOLAR DEVELOPMENT COMMITMENTS

(Under Section 16 of the Electricity Act, Cap. 157)

This Policy Direction is given to the Electricity Regulatory Authority in accordance with Section 16 of the Electricity Act, Cap. 157, this **8th** day of **May 2026**.

PREAMBLE

- WHEREAS** the Government of Uganda (the "Government") in the National Energy Policy for Uganda published in 2023 set out the Government's policy aspiration to meet the energy needs of Uganda's population for social and economic development in an environmentally sustainable manner;

- WHEREAS** in achieving the aforementioned objective, the Government has deployed the strategy of disseminating renewable energy technologies to increase their positive impact on Uganda's energy balance and environmental stewardship;
- WHEREAS** the National Energy Policy 2023 aims to achieve an electricity generation capacity of 52,481 MW by 2040;
- WHEREAS** the Renewable Energy Policy for Uganda published in 2007 set out the Government's policy objective to make modern renewable energy a substantial part of the national energy consumption, and to increase the use of modern renewable energy;
- WHEREAS** the Government has undertaken to pursue the principal policy objective of improving power connectivity as provided for in the Fourth National Development Plan and the National Resistance Movement Manifesto 2021-2026;
- WHEREAS** the Government of the Republic of Uganda, through the Electricity Regulatory Authority (ERA), has adopted a Revised Renewable Energy Feed-in Tariff (REFIT) Framework to guide investment in renewable energy generation;
- AND WHEREAS** the Revised REFIT Framework introduces new tariff structures, eligibility criteria, and regulatory conditions aimed at enhancing cost-reflective tariffs, promoting competitive procurement, and ensuring sustainable sector growth;
- AND WHEREAS** a number of companies had entered into commitments, engagements, or negotiations with the Government of Uganda, the Electricity Regulatory Authority (ERA), and other relevant agencies on solar photovoltaic (PV) projects prior to the effective date of the Revised REFIT Framework;
- AND RECOGNIZING** that these companies may have undertaken substantial preparatory work, including feasibility studies, environmental and social impact assessments, land acquisition, and securing preliminary approvals based on the provisions of the earlier REFIT framework;

POLICY DIRECTION

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in the Minister responsible for Energy under the Electricity Act, and in line with the Government's commitment to maintaining investor confidence, policy stability, and equitable treatment:

Applicability of Old REFIT

All solar power projects for which formal engagements with the Government of Uganda and/or ERA were initiated and recorded before the official commencement date of the Revised REFIT Framework shall be processed under the terms and conditions of the previous REFIT framework in effect at the time of their engagement.

Eligibility Criteria

For a project to qualify under this directive, the developer must demonstrate evidence of:

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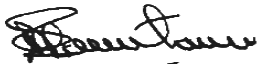
- Written correspondence, MoUs, or Letters of Intent issued by or to the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Development (MEMD) and/or ERA prior to the revised REFIT commencement date;
- Submission of a complete project proposal or feasibility study to ERA prior to the revised REFIT commencement date; and/or
- Any formal approval, permit, or license granted under the old REFIT regime.

Verification Process

The MEMD, in consultation with ERA shall, within **sixty (60) days** of this directive, verify and publish a list of qualifying projects, including details of their capacity, location, developer, and applicable old REFIT tariff.

Implementation Responsibility

The MEMD in conjunction with ERA shall take the necessary steps to implement this directive and shall report to the Minister on progress within **ninety (90) days**.
