**POLICY DIRECTION WITH RESPECT TO THE
DEVELOPMENT OF THE AMEA POWER LLC ITUKA
SOLAR POWER PLANT IN MADI OKOLLO DISTRICT**
(Under section 17 of the Electricity Act, Cap. 145)

This Policy Direction is given to the Electricity Regulatory
Authority under section 17 of the Electricity Act, Cap. 145, this
17th day of February, 2022.

PREAMBLE

- WHEREAS** the Government of Uganda (the “Government”) in the National Energy Policy for Uganda published in 2002 set out the Government’s policy aspirations to meet the energy needs of Uganda’s population for social and economic development in an environmentally sustainable manner, with the National Energy Policy spelling out the Government’s commitment to the development and use of renewable energy resources for both small and large scale applications; and whereas in achieving this objective, the Government has deployed the strategy of disseminating renewable energy technologies to increase their positive impact on Uganda’s energy balance and the environment;

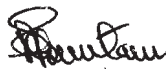

2. **WHEREAS** the Government in the Renewable Energy Policy for Uganda, 2007 set out the Government's policy objective to make modern renewable energy a substantial part of the national energy consumption, and to increase the use of modern renewable energy; and whereas in relation to small power schemes limited to 20 MWac installed capacity per plant, Government has deployed the strategy of licensing the private sector to implement and operate these schemes;
3. **WHEREAS** the Government has undertaken to pursue the principal policy objective of improving power connectivity and supply in the West Nile Region as provided for in the National Development Plan III 2020-2025 (*Section 284*) and the National Resistance Movement Manifesto 2021-2026 (*Section 4.2.2*); and
4. **NOTING THAT** AMEA Power LLC, acting through its special purpose project company Ituka West Nile Uganda Limited, has completed the required preliminary feasibility studies and received a conditional licence award from the Electricity Regulatory Authority in relation to the establishment of a solar power plant in Ombachi Village, Uleppi Sub-County, Madi-Okollo District;

POLICY DIRECTION

5. **NOW THEREFORE**, the following Policy Direction is given to the Electricity Regulatory Authority to observe and implement:
 - (a) AMEA Power LLC, acting through its special purpose project company Ituka West Nile Uganda Limited, shall finance, construct, operate and maintain a 20MWac solar power plant in Ombachi Village, Uleppi Sub-County, in Madi-Okollo District at a tariff of United States cents 8.0 per kilowatt-hour; and
 - (b) the power purchase agreement to be entered into between the special purpose project company, Ituka West Nile Uganda Limited; and the Uganda Electricity Transmission Company Limited shall include a deemed energy clause.

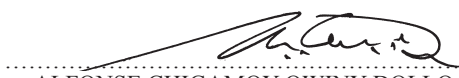
